<i>Largo</i>	<i>broadly</i>	<i>50–55 BPM</i>
<i>Larghetto</i>	<i>rather broadly</i>	<i>55–60 BPM</i>
<i>Adagio</i>	<i>slow and stately</i>	<i>60–72 BPM</i>
<i>Adagietto</i>	<i>slower than Andante</i>	<i>72–80 BPM</i>
<i>Andantino</i>	<i>slightly slower than Andante</i>	<i>80–84 BPM</i>
<i>Andante</i>	<i>at a walking pace</i>	<i>84–90 BPM</i>
<i>Andante moderato</i>	<i>between andante and moderato</i>	<i>90–96 BPM</i>
<i>Marcia moderato</i>	<i>moderately, in the manner of march</i>	<i>83–85 BPM</i>
<i>Moderato</i>	<i>moderately</i>	<i>96–108 BPM</i>
<i>Allegro moderato</i>	<i>moderately fast</i>	<i>108–112 BPM</i>
<i>Allegretto</i>	<i>close to but not quite allegro</i>	<i>112–120 BPM</i>
<i>Allegro</i>	<i>fast, quickly, and bright</i>	<i>120–128 BPM</i>
<i>Vivace</i>	<i>lively and fast</i>	<i>132–144 BPM</i>
<i>Vivacissimo</i>	<i>very fast and lively</i>	<i>144–160 BPM</i>
<i>Allegrissimo</i>	<i>very fast</i>	<i>145–167 BPM</i>
<i>Presto</i>	<i>extremely fast</i>	<i>168–200 BPM</i>
<i>Prestissimo</i>	<i>even faster than Presto</i>	<i>200 BPM and over</i>
